HEATH -- LICCO Inc., the employment workshop operated by the Licking County Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities (LCBMRDD), recently recognized Rob Spellman of Newark as Team Member of the Month for December.

He was selected for this honor based on his dedication.

"He will do any work activity that is asked of him," said Workshop Specialist Jaclyn Alexander. "He especially likes group activities and safety meetings. He enjoys coming to work and socializing with his peers and staff."

Spellman currently works at LICCO three days per week. He has been employed at the workshop since August 1993.

The LCBMRDD provides comprehensive services to about 1,300 Licking County children and adults with mental retardation and other developmental disabilities. The agency currently offers preschool and early intervention services at the E.S. Weiant Center in Newark; early intervention services at the Ann Davino Center in Pataskala; adult services at LICCO Inc. in Heath; residential supports; family respite; transportation services; and service coordination.

The LCBMRDD is nationally accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) for providing high-quality support services to individuals with disabilities and their families.
