## Community impact

Everyone has a family member, friend, neighbor or coworker with a developmental disability. People with developmental disabilities need our help. With assistance, they can contribute to making our community a better place for all. It is our hope that through the Licking County Board of Developmental Disabilities Endowment Fund, we can ease the challenges families face in caring for and nurturing loved ones with developmental disabilities through:

- **Respite care** - a short period of rest or relief from caregiving responsibilities;
- **Adaptive equipment** such as wheelchairs, walkers and communication-enhancing devices;
- **Home modifications** such as ramps and accessible bathrooms; and
- **Recreational experiences** such as camps, trips and sporting events.

## Benefits of the endowment

Building a substantial endowment means building a caring community in which everyone can see the possibilities in people with developmental disabilities. For families in Licking County, the endowment offers more opportunities for their loved ones to improve the quality of their lives.

For the donor, the benefits fulfill a personal calling to help others. This may include honoring the memory of a loved one, or making a contribution to a cause that is near and dear to your heart.

## Endowment goals

It is the intent of the Licking County Board of Developmental Disabilities to build the Endowment Fund to \$150,000.

Once this goal is achieved, the interest income will be dispersed annually to make the greatest long-term impact on our community.

## Ways to give

Please consider this endowment when making future charitable donations. It is a special gift that will continue to benefit the community well into the future.

There are a variety of ways to give:

- **Donations** - Outright contributions are welcome in any amount, at any time.
- **Bequests** - Contributions can be made through your Last Will and Testament.
- **Memorials** - Memorial gifts to the endowment are encouraged on the occasion of the death of a loved one, a deceased loved one's birthday, anniversary of their death, or any time you deem appropriate. - **Life Insurance** - Life insurance can be used to make gifts to the endowment, either as a beneficiary or a separate policy.
