Board of Developmental Disabilities to host informational meetings for families

NEWARK -- In an effort to communicate directly with families who receive agency services, the Licking County Board of Developmental Disabilities (LCBDD) will host several meetings later this month and in February.

Superintendent Nancy Neely will conduct the sessions, with the primary purpose to:

- Update families with sons or daughters who are on waiting lists for either the Level 1 or Individual Options Medicaid Waivers;
- Provide updates on the LCBDD's financial situation; and
- Discuss ways families can participate and assist the board to better serve the community.
