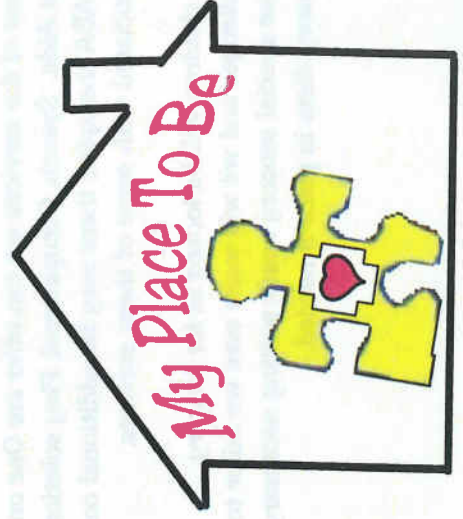

About our Summer Program

Each week we will learn about a new location as we explore the globe. We will be looking at Art, Culture, Cuisine and Science of each country we visit.

We will be having special field trips off site along the way. Parents will be given information prior to the events.



My Place To Be takes an individual approach to learning and providing services. Since we work with children on the Autism Spectrum we want to provide services for children at every developmental level.

Our Basic Camp is a 6:2 ratio with one general Counselor and one assistant counselor per group of six. We realize some children may not be successful in this type of setting, so we will meet with parents and school if required to help decide which program fits best for the child. We will look to see if there are any additional services that should be added for a successful summer experience.

Some of the services we can offer are One on One Aide, Speech, Occupational, Play solutions or ABA therapies, there may be additional cost associated with some of these services.

All children will be looked at for sensory challenges and we will make sure we tailor to those special sensory needs putting necessary sensory diets in place if needed.

My Place To Be's focus is teaching children social skills in a fun and nurturing way, so we will be meeting a new friend each week as well with Camp MakeBelieve. This is a Parent Award winning program that helps children learn ways to self regulate, meet and keep friends to become emotionally competent kids.
