Developmental Disabilities Board to hold public hearing

NEWARK -- The Licking County Board of Developmental Disabilities will conduct two public hearings on Wednesday, October 19. The first session will be from noon to 1 p.m., and the second from 7 to 8 p.m.

Both hearings will be held at the County Board's Administration Offices in the Eleanor S. Weiant Center, 116 N. 22nd St., Newark. The offices are wheelchair accessible.

The purpose of the hearings is to give the public an opportunity to provide input into the Board's Annual Action Plan for 2012. The 2011 Annual Action Plan may be viewed on the agency's website at www.LCountyDD.org.

The Licking County Board of Developmental Disabilities provides comprehensive services to more than 1,400 Licking County infants, children and adults with developmental disabilities. In addition to operating the Administration Offices at the E.S. Weiant Center (the former Starlight School), the agency also provides home-based Early Intervention services to babies and toddlers; Adult Services at LICCO Inc., Heath; contracted transportation services through the Licking County Transit Board; Service Coordination; residential supports; and family support services such as respite care and adaptive equipment. The Licking County Board is nationally accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) for providing high-quality supports and services to individuals with disabilities and their families.
