## **County Board of Developmental Disabilities to host Oct. 22 Wellness and Resource Fair**

NEWARK – The Licking County Board of Developmental Disabilities (LCBDD) will host a Wellness and Resource Fair from 3 to 7 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 22. It will be held in the gymnasium of the Eleanor S. Weiant Center, 116 N. 22<sup>nd</sup> St., Newark.

The Wellness and Resource Fair is open to the public, and is intended as an informational event for the more than 1,300 individuals served by the LCBDD and their families. Admission is free. Health screenings will be conducted, and attendees will have opportunities to learn more about local home health agencies, providers of services for people with developmental disabilities, emergency assistance, therapy providers, recreational activities, estate planning, financial services and more.

Refreshments will be available, and a bake sale and gift-basket silent auction will be held. All proceeds benefit Citizens for Developmental Disabilities.
